To Whom It May Concern:

Last fall, we notified you of Honeywell's application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) for an Individual Waterfront Development Permit under the Coastal Permitting Rule. This permit is one of several that will allow us to implement a remedy for a portion of the Hackensack River riverbed near the former Roosevelt Drive-in site along Route 440 in Jersey City. The remedy will be implemented under the supervision of the federal court.

We have obtained the NJDEP permit. The next step is to obtain the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers' permit.

Once we have all the permits required for this project, we will host a public information meeting to outline the details of the remedy. You and your neighbors will be notified of this meeting.
